Dr. Michael Lisi

Dr. Michael Lisi is a general surgeon and Chief of Staff at Collingwood General and Marine Hospital (CGMH) in Collingwood. Michael also holds other leadership positions on the hospital's Quality Assure Committee, Credentials Committee, and the CGMH board of directors. Michael's leadership also extends beyond CGMH with roles as medical director of Georgian Bay Endoscopy and Collingwood Surgery, member of the Georgian Bay Oncology Steering Committee, and Adjunct Assistant Clinical Professor for the Departments of Surgery at McMaster University and University of Toronto.

Michael created and continues to lead CGMH's Patient Task Force (PTF), which is intended to improve patient flow throughout CGMH and into the community. PTF follows the patient's journey from admission to discharge and addresses how to improve the patient experience. To improve post-surgery recovery, Michael formed the Enhanced Recovery After Surgery Committee, which uses best practice guidelines and tools to enhance post-surgical recovery.

During his tenure a clinical preceptor of the Rural Ontario Medical Program, Michael was a mentor to students. He leads by example, putting his patients first in all aspects of care and teaching his students to do the same.
